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## Overview

The need to transfer coursework from one institution to another is often a requirement for obtaining a degree. It is the goal of the [iTransfer website](#) to be a portal for students to make informed decisions about transferring within Illinois. The site provides vital information to these students in order to help determine their path, start a plan, and get the most out of the institutions they choose to attend.

The website represents the efforts of more than 1000 faculty and staff members working across the State. This includes the Illinois Board of Higher Education, the Illinois Community College Board, the Illinois State Board of Education and the Transfer Coordinators of Illinois Colleges and Universities, all of whom participated in the development of the Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI) curriculum guidelines beginning in 1993. IAI remains an important part of the site but is no longer the site's only function.

Significant factors in the success of the dissemination of transfer information include access to current and accurate information on specific institutional courses that meet the Initiative's agreements, management of the information, marketing of the iTransfer website, and training of staff.

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## Populations Served

Between July 1, 2016, and June 30, 2017, the site processed 121,633 visits to the site with 75,703 being unique visitors. There were 691,096 page views with an average of 5.68 pages viewed per visit. The primary audience the site is serving are the more than 55,300 transfer students who transferred institutions in 2016.\* In addition to transfer students and their families, iTransfer serves the faculty and staff of the institutions within the state. Of those institutions, 95 institutions participated in the IAI this year as

full participants and 19 institutions are receiving only institutions for a total of 114 participating institutions. (For a list of schools, see the iTransfer.org site at [List of Participating Institutions.](#))

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## FY2017 Summary

As technologies improve and change, the iTransfer team makes improvements to the site. The continual improvement allows the site to remain an up-to-date and important tool for transfer information within the state.

Currently, the website's database houses a total of 6,940 active GECC courses and 2,352 active Major courses, which is 9,292 active courses in IAI. Table 1a is the course population statistics for IAI GECC and Baccalaureate Majors courses for all current and future dates.

The overall objective for the iTransfer staff was to continue to enhance and develop the iTransfer.org website, to support the IAI Major and Transferable GECC package, and prepare the annual iTransfer report, which includes annual objectives as well as a summary of the program.

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## FY 2017 Accomplishments

In FY 2017, the following goals, projects, and activities were completed. Many of these projects and activities will continue in FY 2018.

Staff:

- Monitored and maintained iTransfer business continuation activities to include existing systems and function – revised as necessary. – FY 2018
- Edited and “fine-tuned” systems, including marketing activities effectively meeting client needs.
- Installed and implemented new software and applications to facilitate database and web application design. – FY 2018
- Reviewed current software on the market to ensure iTransfer is utilizing technologies appropriate for the best functionality. – FY 2018
- Worked with internal resources at our host institution to begin a full reworking and redesign of the iTransfer.org site. This work continues into the fiscal year 2018. The target date to deploy the new site has been set for before the end of the new fiscal year. This target date is flexible as internal resources have many priorities beyond the iTransfer site redesign.
- Continued to upload courses into the course review system for panel review at spring and fall session meetings. – FY 2018
  - This included monitoring the electronic processes involved in submission and via iManage.
- Worked to improve performance and user satisfaction. – FY 2018
- Attended various IAI GECC and Major Panel meetings in spring and fall sessions. – FY 2018
- Continued the use of the join.me web conferencing programming for remote participants in general education meetings. We will be moving to an internal product purchased in association with our host institution in the coming year.
- Created meeting summaries for meetings iTransfer staff attended. Staff also assisted the Boards as requested with posting agendas and summaries of other IAI panel related meetings. – FY 2018
- Assisted participating institutions with staff training and technical directions/implementation. – FY 2018
- Reviewed and enhanced training materials. We developed a section within the new site that

provides training to the specific functions of our institutional users. Work on developing enhancing, and deploying this training section with continue.

- Worked to implement recommendations from the Boards and the Steering Panel for IAI and iTransfer. – FY 2018
- Researched website and server technologies to ensure that iTransfer.org reflects current web practices and made changes accordingly. – FY 2018
- Completed the process of transferring all our server functionality to a virtual server structure. We implemented this process with the assistance and support of our host institution, Illinois State University.
- Continued to develop and implement the IAI/iTransfer marketing plan. – FY 2018
- Continued to focus on iTransfer.org as a portal for transfer within the state. Staff strove to keep this focus in the new site redesign. – FY 2018
- Continued technology research, development, and implementation plan. – FY 2018
- Met frequently to discuss projects, marketing opportunities and look at refining site aspects to increase satisfaction with site functionality. – FY 2018
- Prepared the annual report and identified specific goals for coming year. – FY 2018
- Continued to provide support to our Board constituents. – FY 2018
- Provided assistance and support to the IBHE and ICCB staff as necessary. This included phone meetings and travel to programmatic meetings. Staff provided training as requested. – FY 2018
- Reviewed and revised, as needed, the recently updated iTransfer operations manual and Business Continuation Plan. – FY 2018
- Reviewed Google analytics, site navigation, and user feedback to improve functionality and design of the site. This was of importance in the site content restructure and redesign. This will continue to be an important driving process in site revisions.
- Completed activities related to site and server structure redesign for enhanced business continuation purposes. These included, but were not limited to:
  - Set up of appropriate software and server technologies
  - Bolstering server security from external attacks. – FY 2018
- Completed a variety of programming and report projects in a timely manner that arose via functionality issues in iManage, need by our Board and IAI constituents, as well as other site driven issues. – FY 2018

- Prepare the iTransfer annual summary report for IBHE and ICCB.
- Deploy the new iTransfer.org website before the end of the fiscal year.
